

Bed **(TYPE B)** Assembly Instructions:

The bed is not too difficult to put together but here are some basics for putting it together.

- The first step is to put in all threaded metal dowels. Two go in each side rail (the middle hole where the center supports are attached) and two go in the head and foot rails, (also the center hole). These are to be tightened by hand only.



- Take the two center supports (the shorter pieces with dowels sticking up) and attach them first to the two side rails lining up the metal dowel and the two wooden dowels that are in the center supports. The metal dowel will be seen in the large hole at the end of each center support. Then a washer and nut is placed inside the hole of each center support on the threaded dowel).



- These are tightened with the 7/16 combination wrench.
- Then you attach the side rails to the head board first doing the same lining up the threaded dowel and wooden dowels and then applying the washer and nuts (the nuts go inside the holes of the side rails). Tighten with wrench

- It is a little easier if someone helps at this point holding the other end up level but not absolutely necessary.

- Then do the same to the foot board and you are almost done except tightening the bolts and putting the slats in place. (photo shown has extra slats)

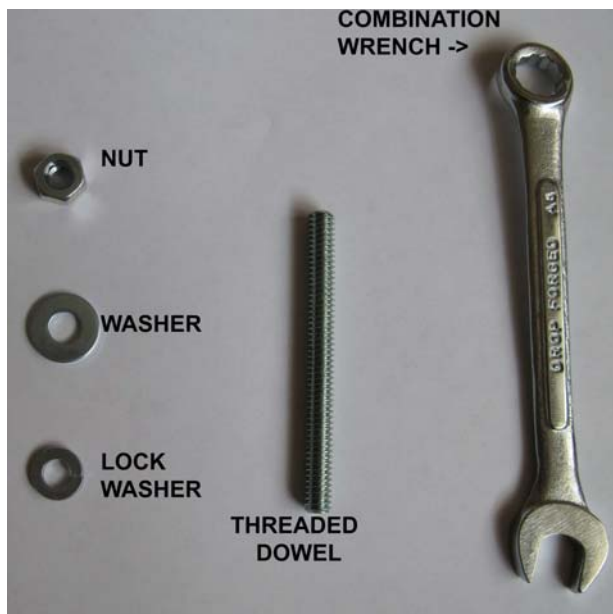
